

# Interview Tapes of Whaling Captains Broadcasted Over ATS-1

BARROW — Tape recorded interviews with whaling captains, with women preparing newly caught whale meat, and with villagers, were broadcasted from Barrow on May 1-13 using the satellite ATS-1.

Interior villages of Ailakaket, Nulato, Ruby, Chalkyitsik and Stevens Village were informed

of whaling as it happened in Barrow.

A live broadcast was also carried on KUAC-FM during, "The People Talk" on the campus of the University of Alaska.

The Arctic Slope Native As-

sociation executive committee spoke over the satellite with the Anaktuvuk Pass council on the new ASNA offices, officers and the forthcoming elections for a borough chairman.

Enrollment progress was also

one of the subjects as well as the new ASNA articles of incorporation.

The sea mammal bill also took up an important slot in the hour-long broadcast.
