The Cook Inlet HOME Program

Tired of paying rent?

Tired of your crowded apartment?

You could possibly own your own home!

Program Information:

- The Cook Inlet HOME Partnership Program is sponsored by Cook Inlet Tribal Council (CITC) and administered by Cook Inlet Housing Authority (CIHA).
- It was created to increase home ownership and affordable housing within the Anchorage area.
- It is designed for Alaska Natives and American Indians who are very low to low-income.
- It provides HOME partnership loans to eligible applicants as they finance a new home.

Who is eligible?

- First time homebuyers (someone who has not owned a home in the past 3 years).
- Applicants who have an annual income at or below HOME Program income limits.
- Applicants who can provide a portion of the initial cash down payment for the house and other related closing costs.
- Applicants who are willing to comply with program requirements.
- Families or individuals

The funding for the Home loans is *Limited* and will be expended on a "*first come first served basis*".
