# Victory High School Graduates 11

The graduation exercises of Victory High School and the Arctic Bible Institute will be held on Friday, May 16th at 7:30 p.m. at the scenic Park Bible Church in Anchorage.

Rev. Robert Lee, Acting Dean of the Alaska Bible College, is slated to deliver the commence-

ment address. These two schools comprise the Arctic Training Center located at Mile 95 on the Glenn Highway.

This is the completion of ten years of operation at this location. Victory High School is a Christian high school which pro-

vides secondary education for native Alaskans.

The Arctic Bible Institute is a specialized school offering instruction in Biblical studies for training of native Christian leaders. This is the first graduating class of the Institute.
