

## Professor Salisbury Invited to Meet on Speech Communication

Professor Lee Salisbury, head of the University of Alaska's Department of Speech, Drama and Radio, is one of twelve educators invited to participate in a developmental conference "Speech Communication and the American Indian High School Student."

The conference, funded by the Danforth Foundation, will

be held at the University of South Dakota May 29 through June 2. It is co-sponsored by the University of Kansas Communication Research Center and the Institute of Indian Studies at the University of South Dakota.

Salisbury, who also is director of the University of Alaska's College Orientation Program for Alaska Native students (COPAN), will head a task force charged with developing a program of oral English for American Indian secondary school pupils at the conference.

## Famous Artist's Works Donated To UA Museum

A Sidney Laurence oil painting and two drawings by George Ahgupuk were recently donated to the University of Alaska Museum by the International Business Machines Corporation.

The paintings, originally part of the I.B.M. collection of American art, were presented to the university through M.H. Evans, manager of the Anchorage I.B.M. branch office.

These new additions to the Museum art collection will be placed on temporary exhibit in the Museum display case in the Bunnell Memorial Building January 23 through February 1.

They join a collection of paintings by Alaskan artists and other Alaskan art now housed in the Museum and campus offices. A gallery for this collection is planned for a proposed new Museum building.

## Gov. Announces Tax Refunds

Governor Walter J. Hickel announced this week that the State Department of Revenue has already processed the first 250 Alaska Individual Income Tax Refunds for 1966. The Department of Administration has mailed the first refunds in total amount of \$11,731.01, for an average refund of \$46.92, he said.

The Department of Revenue of the State of Alaska urges taxpayers to file their claims for refund at an early date with the Department of Revenue, Alaska Office Building, Juneau, Alaska.

Due to the accelerated withholding tax provisions adopted by the State in May of 1966, it is expected that the average amount of individual refunds will be slightly larger than those issued for 1965.

The Department of Revenue during 1966, issued 42,571 individual income tax refunds in total amount of \$1,577,488 for an average refund of \$37.05 for 1965 Alaska Individual Income Tax overpayments.
