That's the way it was in some of
the mining towns of the west. It's
doubtful that it will be like that in
Alaska—but, a lawfully recognized
water right may be very valuable,
possibly not at present, but as
more demands are placed on the
state's water resources, competition
for water will become more intense.
As water use priorities are based
on a "first come, first served"
basis, it is advantageous to holders
of existing rights to establish their
priority as of the date use began.
During the filing period March 1 to
April 30, 1968, Declaration of
Appropriation, DL Form 236, and an
information booklet may be obtained
at the Division of Lands, Room 105,
State Office Building, Fairbanks or
344 6th Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska,
99501.

Please give this matter careful
consideration, and file your
Declaration of Appropriation during
the filing period. If you wait until
water shortages occur, it may be too
late.

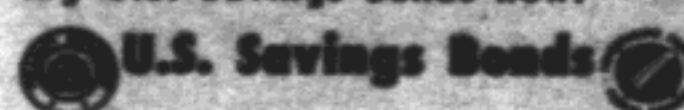
