

Ice Conditions

FAIRBANKS — U.S. Navy maps giving reports and forecasts of sea ice conditions in the Northern Pacific (including the Bering Sea and Alaska's West Coast) are now available to the public through the University of Alaska's Institute of Marine Science in Fairbanks. The maps include description and location of sea ice, air and sea-surface temperatures, and seven and thirty-day forecasts of ice conditions. They are made with the help of satellite photos, and are issued weekly.
