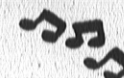

Grant Period July 1, 1985 through June 30, 1986

SENIOR EMPLOYMENT

Federal funds in the amount of approximately \$1,150,000 for the State are expected to be available for award for the employment and training of low-income individuals 55 years or over in accordance with Title V of the Older Americans Act as amended (P.L. 89-73). Employment must contribute to the general welfare of the community. Priority is given to jobs which will lead to an unsubsidized job. Types of jobs currently funded include: Home Chore Workers and other help for the frail elderly, Peer Counselors in Mental Health, Drug Abuse, Alcoholism or other health-related programs; Food Service Workers, Drivers, Outreach Workers, Elderly Resource Aides, Instructors, Translators, and others. Employment may not result in the displacement of currently employed workers and must result in an increase in employment opportunities.

Eligible applicants: public or private nonprofit agencies or organizations units of local government, and Alaskan or tribal organizations not organized for profit. For profit businesses are eligible for contractors totaling \$25,000.

Grant applications must be postmarked not later than March 1, 1985 and are available as follows:
