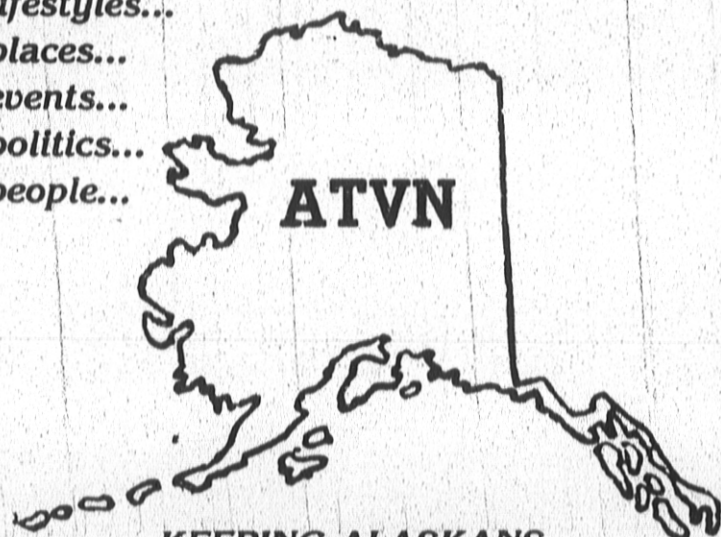

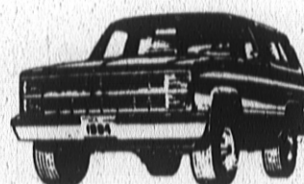

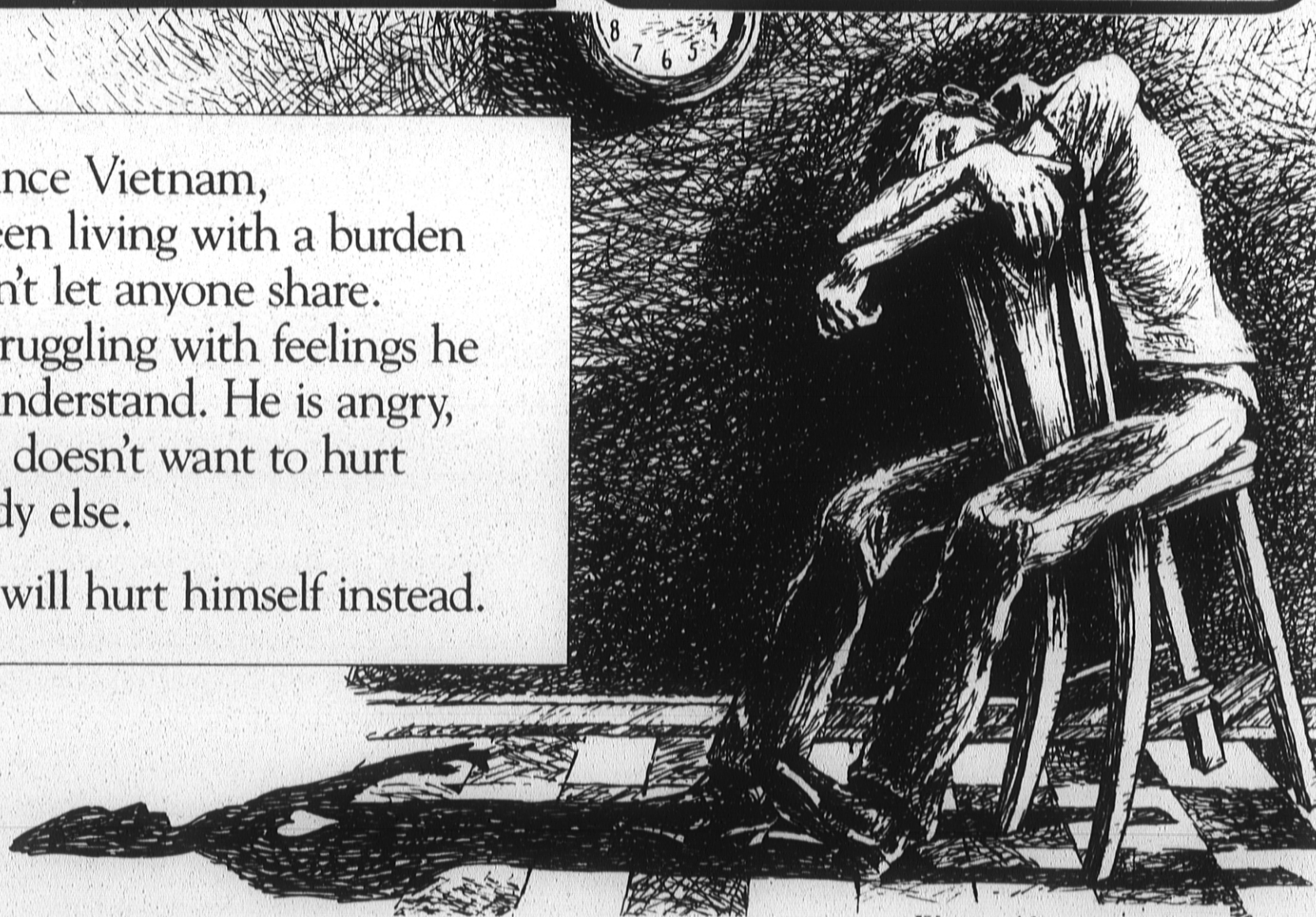

tion, and recommend action and
facilities. They'll help you to cope
with the situation yourself, so that
you can deal with it effectively.
They'll help you decide what to do
next.
