## High Court refuses

The United State Supreme Court refused Monday to overrule the Court of Appeals decision which held that the

Department of the Interior can-

not issue a permit to the Aleyska

Pipeline Service Co. granting a

wider right-of-way than the

Mineral Leasing Act allows.

The Supreme Court refusal throws the burden onto the United States Congress whom

must either revise the 1925 Act

or pass legislation which will allow special provisions for the trans-Alaska pipeline.

Senator Ted Stevens said the Supreme Court ruling would

mean that construction will not

begin this year, and may not even get underway next season.
