

Anchorage Native Center Extended For Six Months

Cook Inlet Native Association announces that the Anchorage Urban Native Center has received a six month extension from Office of Economic Opportunity to continue operations.

The Urban Native Center is located at 3350 Commercial Drive in Anchorage and offers a variety of services for Native people with housing, welfare, medical and other problems.

An active manpower program provides assistance and referral for employment is available training programs.

Legal Assistance for people who qualify is available through the cooperation of the Legal Service Program during the hours of 9:00 AM-12:00 PM every Wednesday at the Center.

Through the CINA Arts & Crafts Shop Native artisens are afforded a place to work and a sales outlet for their products.

Assistance and referral is also provided for incoming and outgoing Natives at the Airport Native Assistance Center located in the terminal building at the International Airport.
