

St. Mary's Projects Bids Rejected on All Items

Bids on St. Mary's dock and cold storage and multi-purpose community building have been rejected on all items, Paul T. Dixon revealed this week. Dixon is the executor of the village of St. Mary's.

All bids submitted were in excess of the project moneys available.

As a result, decision has been made to redesign the projects and offer them for rebid on or about January 1, 1969. This was decided after a conference by the village and Economic Development Administration.

The intended revisions are:

—Consolidating both projects into one project for finance and construction purposes.

—The multi-purpose building will be erected on top of the cold storage building eliminating need for construction of two foundations and effecting economies in such areas as plumbing, heating, electrical wiring, etc.

—The combined structures will be erected on a new location to take advantage of a solid rock foundation.

Copy of the bid results has been sent to the bidders.
