

Examination Open for Holy Cross Postmaster Until September 10

An examination for Postmaster at Holy Cross, Alaska \$6,348 a year, will be open for acceptance of applications until September 10, 1968, the Commission announced last week.

All qualified applicants will receive consideration for appointment without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex, politics, or any other non-merit factor.

Complete information about the examination requirements and instructions for filing applications may be obtained at the post office for which this examination is being announced. Application forms must be filed with the U. S. Civil Service Commission, Washington, D.C. 20415, and must be received or postmarked not later than the closing date.

Competitors for the postmaster vacancy in this city must:

—have at least 1 year of experience (education above high school level may be substituted for 6 months of experience) showing that they have the ability to maintain simple

records or accounts or that it has given them a knowledge of postal procedures;

—show that they are of good reputation and that they can meet and deal with the public agreeably and effectively;

—have resided within the delivery of the post office for one year immediately preceding the closing date of the examination;

—have reached their 18th birthday on the closing date for acceptance of applications;

There is no written test for the position. Applicants will be rated competitively on evaluation of their experience and fitness for the position.

Persons over 70 years of age cannot be appointed.
