

Pollock Announces Flood Control Survey Fund

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Congressman Howard W. Pollock announced that the Subcommittee on Flood Control of the House Public Works Committee has approved his resolution allocating \$4,200,000 for a Comprehensive Flood Control Survey of Alaska's Rivers and Harbors.

Pollock said now the measure goes to the Full Committee which is expected to approve it this week. After favorable Committee approval, funds to implement the study must be appropriated.

The Congressman remarked that "This kind of study will provide an efficient base of information so that Alaska can proceed in a planned comprehensive program of Flood Control rather than piecemeal emergency measures."
