#### TEACHER'S RETIREMENT BOARD NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Teachers' Retirement Board, under authority vested by AS 14.25.022 and 14.25.035, proposes to amend or adopt the following regulations:

(1) 2 AAC 36.080, FORM OF NOTICE. This regulation outlines the information required from individuals who are appealing to the Teachers' Retirement Board. The proposed amendment would clarify the current language, but does not affect the intent.

(2) 2 AAC 36.100, SCHEDULING APPEAL. This regulation sets out requirements for scheduling appeal hearings. The proposed amendment adds a provision to allow appellants to waive their right to hearing within 120 days.

(3) 2 AAC 36.110, PRESENTATION OF EVIDENCE. This regulation sets out the time requirements for an appellant and the division to submit evidence to the board. The proposed amendment adds a provision to allow the appellant and the division to agree to other times for submission of evidence.

(4) 2 AAC 36.225, BENEFIT ADJUSTMENTS. This proposed regulation would allow benefit overpayments and under payments which are less than \$3,500 to be paid in a lump sum payment.
