

North State Phone Co. Asks for Tariff Revision

The Alaska Public Utilities Commission has received an application from North State Telephone Company, Inc. for a revision of its tariff which proposes to eliminate the offering of two-party and four-party business and residential telephone service in Kotzebue.

Under the provision of the proposed revision, the utility

would offer only private line service in this exchange.

The rates for this service would remain at \$21.00 per month for a business telephone and \$14.50 for residential service.
