The Program will be taught in two (2) K-2 classrooms by two (2) teachers with Alaska teaching certificates and Montessori certification. Each class will have a total of 30 students: 10 Kindergarteners (5 morning/5 afternoon), 10 first graders and 10 second graders.

1. All parents wishing to enroll a student in the Denali Montessori Alternative Program must complete a lottery application form. (Forms are available at Denali School; Elementary Education, Second floor of ASD Administration Building, 4600 DeBarr Avenue; or by calling Elementary Education at 269-2290.)
2. Students will be enrolled in the Program through the ASD Lottery Procedures: Denali students will be placed in the program first; students from other schools will be placed in the program on a space available basis.
3. The first lottery is scheduled for **May 31, 1985**. The next lottery will be held on August 21, 1985.
