

Land Use Council to hold meeting

The Alaska Land Use Council's Land Use Advisors Committee will meet in Anchorage on Thursday and Friday, March 28 and 29, 1985 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the Council's Conference Room, 1689 "C" Street, Suite 107.
