

Quebec CBS-TV Spurns Eskimo, Cree Broadcasts

Three television stations planned for Northern Quebec are being required to meet with the Inuit Association of native peoples.

The Canadian Broadcasting System planned to present programs in both English and French, but native residents in the area state they will approve the stations only if they also carry some Eskimo and Cree language broadcasting.

Marcel Quimet, vice-president of CBC said there were no funds for native language broadcasting at the present time.
