

Kwigillingok, Newtok— *To Get Airport Facilities*

JUNEAU — Governor William A. Egan said the state has awarded two contracts totaling \$500,357 for construction of airports at Kwigillingok and Newtok — both in the lower Kuskokwim region.

Egan said new airport facilities at each community will include a 2,500-foot runway, a

parking apron and taxiway, and an access road.

The \$204,900 Kwigillingok project, awarded to Herman Brothers Construction Co. of Palmer, is to be completed in October, and the work at Newtok, totaling \$295,457, is scheduled for completion in June.

It is being done by Burgess Construction Co. of Fairbanks.
