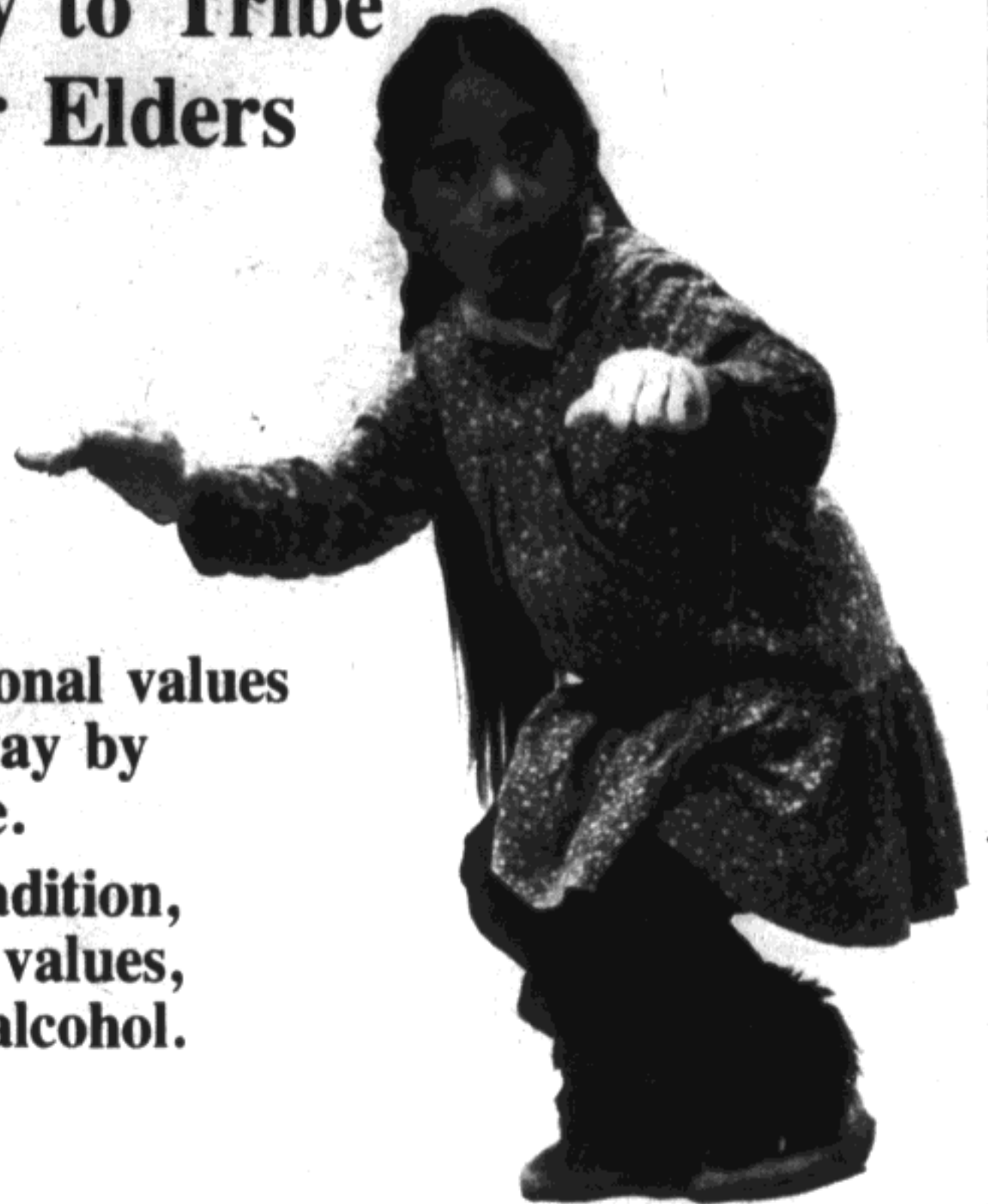

Sealed Bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and performing all work on Project No. AIP 3-02-0218-01/83896, Huslia Airport Improvements described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, August 29, 1989 in the Office of the Chief of Technical Services, Technical Services Building, Room 4, 2301Pager Road, Fairbanks, Alaska.

The project will consist of extending and resurfacing the existing runway, taxiway, and apron; construction of an airport lighting system and equipment storage building; and additive alternates for a motor grader and aggregate surface course stabilization at Huslia, approximately 260 miles west of Fairbanks.

Engineer's Estimate is between \$500,000 and \$1,000,000.

Principal items of work include the following: All required, Equipment Storage Building; all required, Clearing; 7,400 cubic yards of Unclassified Excavation; 13,900 cubic yards of Borrow Embankment; 6,400 cubic yards of Aggregate Surface Course; and all required, Runway and Taxiway Lighting.

All work shall be completed by October 1, 1990.
