

CITC sponsors lunch program for Native elders

The Cook Inlet Tribal Council is sponsoring an Elders Lunch Program funded through the Title VI of the Older Americans Act, according to CITC.

Elders' meals will be served two times a week, Tuesdays and Fridays. The only requirement to qualify for the program is that people be at least 60 years of age and either Alaska Native or American Indian Heritage.

Donations will be encouraged, and the proceeds will be put back into the program to fund additional activities in the future.
