

Appointed to Land Law Group

Rep. Ralph J. Rivers has been appointed to the Public Land Law Review Commission recently. The year-old 18-member commission was created by act of congress to study laws pertaining to federally-owned lands and the rules and regulations of all federal agencies charged with the management and disposition of such land.

The appointment resulted when Congressman Leo O'Brien of New York resigned. Rivers was named to the position by Speaker John McCormack.
