bachelor's degrees can apply to the Harvard Graduate School of Arts and Sciences. Persons admitted to a Harvard Ph.D. program can expect to receive at least five years of full-time registration with tuition and fees of \$16,000 and a living stipend of \$10,500 per year. (You do not have to have a master's degree to enter this program and it can be used to obtain a second doctorate.) More than 50 professional fields of study are available.
