

# Human Rights Commission to Meet June 4-5

**ANCHORAGE**—The Board of Commissioners to the Alaska Commission for Human Rights will meet in Anchorage on June 4 and 5.

This announcement came from Robert Willard, the newly appointed Executive Director of the state agency. This will be Willard's first meeting with the five-member board since he took office on April 22.

Willard replaced Willard L. Bowman who resigned on February 15 of this year.

The Commission is charged with the responsibility of enforcing laws against discrimination in employment, public accommodations, housing, and financial dealings that are based on race, color, and national origin.

This agency also investigates complaints of sex, age, religion and physical handicap in employment.
