

Alaska Magazine Poses Problems Of Environment

Rising concern of Americans with environmental problems—and their special interest in Alaska's wilderness—is reflected in the June issue of Alaska magazine.

Three separate editorial sections are devoted entirely to more than 40 letters from readers for the first time in the magazine's 35-year history.
