The Board of Directors of RurAL CAP met April 30th and May 1st in Kodiak. In the order of business, the Executive Committee was directed by the Board to act as their representative in promoting the legislation for the passage of three bills:

1) Head Start, 2) Unorganized Borough, and 3) Funding of

Regional Corporations. The Committee was instructed to expend every possible effort during the remainder of the legislative session to either pass the bills in their present form, or make the necessary corrections acceptable to both the legislature and the rural people of Alaska.
