

National Park Service offers copies of 9 plans

The National Park Service recently announced that a limited number of copies of the nine general management plans adopted in November are available to the public on a first-come, first-served basis.

These are the plans that will govern park management over the next five

to 10 years at nine Alaska parks: Bering Land Bridge National Preserve, Denali National Park and Preserve, Gates of the Arctic National Park and Preserve, Katmai National Park and Preserve, Aniakchak National Monument and Preserve, Kobuk Valley National Park, Cape Krusenstern Na-

tional Monument, Noatak National Preserve and Wrangell-St. Elias National Park and Preserve.

Copies of the plans will be available for reference use at all park headquarters, at the Alaska Regional Office of the Park Service and at these libraries: The Alaska Resources

Library in the Anchorage Federal Building, the Alaska State Library in Juneau and the Noel Wien Memorial Library in Fairbanks.
