The Decorated Moccasin is an international footwear competition open to Native craftspeople throughout Canada and the United States, according to the Department of Interior's Indian Arts and Crafts Board.

A total of \$6,000 in cash prizes will be awarded. The six competition categories are based on types of decoration, which include quillwork, beadwork, moosehair tufting and/or embroidery, thread embroidery, ribbonwork and painted or pigmentation. The competition is being sponsored by the Canadian Native Arts Foundation and the Bata Shoe Museum Foundation.
