

CIRI Joint Venture gains two gasline contracts

CIRI/H&N Alaska, a joint venture between Cook Inlet Region and Holmes & Narver has been awarded two contracts for work on the Northwest Alaska gas pipeline project by Fluor Northwest, Inc.

One contract is for a reconnaissance survey of temporary construction camps and the other for architectural and engineering design services of temporary construction camps for the Northwest Alaskan Pipeline Project.

CIRI/H&N will provide the following architectural engineering services in support of this project:

- The rehabilitation of the existing Trans-Alaskan Oil Pipeline camps.
- Site relocation of three of the camps and eight pipeline pump station camps.
- The conversion of existing barracks at Fort Wainwright to dormitories for workers.
