Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to AS 14.48 relating to regulation of postsecondary educational institutions, the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education proposes to adopt a new regulation in Title 20 of the Alaska Administrative Code which is summarized as follows:

20 AAC 20.005. Adopts by reference the "Guideline for State Approved Programs Enrolling Veterans", Volume III, No. One, and the "Alaska Guideline for Veterans Administration Approved Commercial Flight Schools", Volume III, No. One, developed by the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education.

These guides contain a listing of approval practices that the school industry must comply with in enrolling veterans under U.S.C. 38 is not being restrictive in its regulation of certain postsecondary educational institutions, these guidelines are available upon request for review by concerned persons before adoption.
