

St. Mary's Seeks Proposals

ST. MARY'S — The City of St. Mary's is asking for proposals for an operation and management agreement covering the Kumeliuik facilities here.

This is a multipurpose building containing a five-room hotel, restaurant, city clinic, auditorium, Calista office, Post Office, cold storage freezing, processing and storage facilities.

The agreement is to provide operation and management of the building and grounds to meet needs of tenants and lease of the hotel section and restaurant. Inclusion of the auditorium as part of the leased facilities is optional.

Tenants include the City Clinic, Calista area office, U.S. Post Office and King Island Fisheries. The St. Mary's School District may want to continue serving its hot lunch program through the Kumeliuik until new high school facilities are ready, probably in February of next year, according to Moses Paukan, mayor.
