REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF INTENT TO BID TURKEY INDIAN HOUSING PROJECTS

The NANA Regional Housing Authority in compliance with Federal regulations regarding Indian Preference in contracting, will receive until February 25, 1981, Statement of Intent from Indian-owned Economic Enterprises, to respond to a limited advertisement for bids for the

design and construction of the following Indian Housing projects under the Turnkey method:

- A. Amblar - HUD Project - Consisting of twenty-five (25) single family dwelling units.
- B. Shungnak - HUD Project - Consisting of eighteen (18) single family dwelling units.
- C. Kobuk - HUD Project - Consisting of ten (10) single family dwelling units.
- D. Osiering - HUD Project - Consisting of four (4) single family dwelling units.
- E. Buckland - HUD Project - Consisting of twenty-two (22) single family dwelling units.
- F. Selawik - HUD Project - Consisting of thirty-six (36) single family dwelling units.
- G. Kiana - HUD Project - Consisting of sixteen (16) single family dwelling units.

H. Noorvik - HUD Project - Consisting of twenty-two (22) single family dwelling units.

I. Kivalina - HUD Project - Consisting of eleven (11) single family dwelling units.

Proposals for any single village or all villages will be accepted. Interested prospective contractors shall submit a Statement of Intent with evidence sufficient to establish their qualifications as an Indian organization or Indian-owned Economic Enterprise. This evidence shall consist of:

- A. Evidence showing fully the extent of Indian ownership and interest.
- B. Evidence of organizational structure, management and financing affecting the Indian character of the enterprise, including major subcontractors and purchase agreements; material or equipment supply arrangements; and management, salary or profit-sharing arrangement; and evidence showing the effect of these on the extent of Indian ownership and interest.
- C. Evidence sufficient to demonstrate the satisfaction of the NANA Regional Housing Authority and HUD that the respective contractor has the technical, administrative and financial capability to perform contract work of the size and type involved and within the time provided under the proposed contract.

Indian-owned Economic Enterprises which are not interested in bidding as a general contractor but are interested in subcontracting or supplying contracts related to these projects should submit a Statement of Intent to stating interest in subcontracting and suppliers will be forwarded a copy of the bidders list on these projects so that they may contact the general contractors directly.
