## Social Services

Tanana Chiefs Conference Native Services Department has created a Social Services Division to deliver services to 35 villages within the Tanana Chiefs Region, effective November 24, 1975.

The Social Services division of TCC Native Services is staffed by a supervisory social worker, a social worker and two social service representatives.

Tanana Chiefs Social Services will provide many of the same types of assistance formerly available thru the Fairbanks Agency of Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The creation of the Social Services Division brings to six the number of programs which were formerly managed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs thru its Fairbanks Agency.

Tanana Chiefs Conference now employees twenty-seven people to administer its BIA contract.

Persons interested in receiving assistance or housing, financial, village government, employment or social services needs who qualify as Alaska Native residents of the Tanana Chiefs Region are encouraged to apply for assistance thru the Tanana Chiefs Conference Native Services Department which is located on the first floor of the Doyon Building on the corner of First and Hall Streets in Fairbanks, phone number is 452-8251.
