The Eskimo village of Wainwright has been granted a loan of \$110,000 by the Farmers Home Administration, U.S. Sen. Ted Stevens announced today.

The 25-year loan at 10% interest will be used to build a warehouse for the Wainwright Cooperative Association store in

Wainwright.

The new warehouse will fulfill a need for better storage facilities at the store which markets raw furs, native Eskimo arts and crafts produced locally, and provides groceries, clothing, equipment, repairs parts, fuel and oil.
