

# Nome Requests APUC

The Alaska Public Utilities Commission has received a request from Nome TV Cable, Inc., for authority to increase its monthly current service charge from the present \$17.50 to \$22.50 per month.

The rate increase would apply

to both residential and commercial service.

The utility states that the proposed increase will yield \$28,140 additional revenue which will make possible continued good service to the community.

Any interested person may file with the Commission by 4:30 P.M., July 28, 1975, a statement of his views and specific reasons in favor of, or in opposition to, the tariff revision proposed by the utility, together with written confirmation that the same statement also has been mailed or delivered to the utility.
