

# Road System For Prince of Wales Island

Alaska Commissioner of Highways Walter B. Parker and Southeastern District Engineer Warren Wild have completed an inspection tour of some parts of Prince of Wales Island west of Ketchikan, seeking additional data for incorporation into the long-range road construction program for the island.

"We drove the existing road from Hollis to Harris River to Craig, toured the route from Klawock to Thorne Bay, and flew the proposed route from the Cross Island Highway to Hydaburg," said Commissioner Parker. "While there are some problems, there is nothing serious enough to make the proposed road system unfeasible."

The long-range program calls for completion of the Cross Island Highway from Hollis to Klawock and Craig, and construction of a new link from Hydaburg to the Cross Island Highway.
