FUEL DELIVERY TO REMOTE VILLAGES IS RATHER DIFFICULT

Fuel delivery to the remote villages below Homer is a rather difficult task — because of weather and because of the

cumbersome method of handling.

This is the only way at the present time to deliver the fuel.

Walt Kodiak has plans to purchase a 4,000 gallon capacity fuel barge. The barge would be able to get into places such as English Bay, which periodically waits for fuel delivery because of

shortage.
