Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project No. 68829 & 69056, Juneau-Egan Drive Spot Improvements, Juneau-10th/12th Street Turn Bays, described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, July 24, 1986, on the second floor, Conference Room, Room 202, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project will consist of bridge and roadway construction at three areas along Egan Street, 12th Street and Egan Drive will be lengthened. This will involve new asphalt paving, curb and gutter. The Gold Creek Bridge roadway approach will be rebuilt, a concrete cap to the existing riprap under the bride will be constructed and the rip rap along Egan Drive will be reconstructed. At Merchant's Wharf approximately 400 feet of roadway will be reconstructed, involving new asphalt, concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter.
