election ballot. The initiative calls for the to declare jurisdiction over most federally controlled land in Alaska. Several western states have taken similar actions challenging federal ownership of land within their boundaries.

The initiative also challenges the constitutionality of certain provisions in the Alaska Statehood Act and the state constitution granting to the state all mineral rights on land transferred to the state, and prohibiting further transfer to private hands.
