

Northern Lights Eskimo dancers at Rondy

The Northern Lights Eskimo troupe from Kotzebue will be a feature of the 1980 Alaska Alaska Review during the Anchorage Fur Rendezvous. The Review is being organized by Bard of Alaska, Larry Beck, and will feature not only the Kotzebue group, but the the Chilkat Indian Dancers from Haines and the New Archangel Russian Dancers from Sitka also. Featured will be Miss Alaska, Lila Oberg, Mother Moose and an Eskimo Olympic demonstration group headed by Kotzebue's Reggie Joule. The appearance of the Kotzebue groups is underwritten by a grant from Wien Air Alaska.

The All Alaska Review will be held at West High Auditorium in Anchorage on February 15, 16 and 17. Shows will be at 4:30 pm and 8:00 pm each evening. In addition to their appearances at the show, the Kotzebue group will present demonstrations of Eskimo blanket tossing and Eskimo Olympic games at various locations throughout the city.

Besides working with the Anchorage Fur Rendezvous in helping to present the Northern Lights Dancers and Olympic group, Wien Air Alaska will be offering a special five day excursion fares to anyone wishing to attend the Anchorage Fur Rendezvous.
