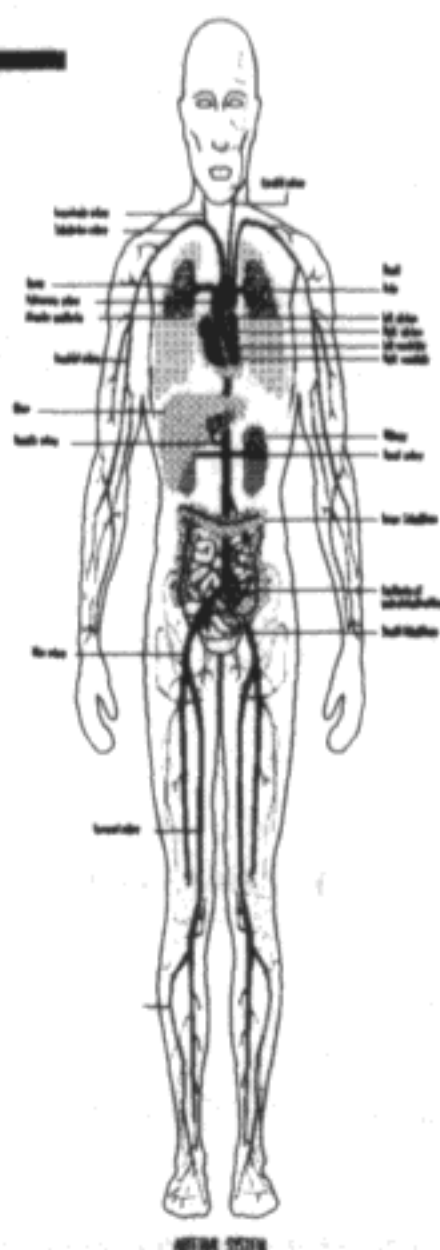

The Aleutian Housing Authority (AHA) is accepting applications from eligible families for participation in our Mutual Help Homeowner Opportunity Program (MH Program), and the Low Rent Public Assisted Housing Program (LR Program). The MH Program enables low to moderate income American Indian/Alaska Native families the opportunity to acquire a home they may not have been able to acquire otherwise. To be eligible for the MH Program applications must meet income limits set by the U.S. Depart. of HUD, be able to meet the payment, utilities and maintenance of the home and be certified American Indian or Alaska Native by a State, Federal or Tribal Government.

Applications to the LR Program will be accepted from all interested low to moderate income persons regardless of race or tribal affiliation. The AHA services and maintains housing in the following Aleutian/Pribilof communities: St. Paul, St. George, Unalaska, Dutch Harbor, Atka, Nikolski, Akutan, Nelson Lagoon, King Cove, Sand Point & False Pass.
