

Northway Rebuilds Hall

Following a mid-December fire that leveled the community hall in Northway, an Athabascan village of some 200 people near the Canada-Alaska border, efforts are being made to reconstruct another facility as soon as possible.

Aside from application for funds from state and federal agencies, a process which may take several months, the village has begun an appeal for assistance from other Alaskans.
