The Thirteenth Regional Native Corporation

The proposal for a thirteen regional Native corporation for Alaska Natives residing outside of the state was defeated in an election in November. Legislation introduced in December by Senator Jackson of Washington would have established the thirteenth. Jackson's bill passed the Senate but was not considered by the House Interior Committee. The bill to create the thirteenth is expected to be reintroduced after Congress reconvenes this month. The following figures show the makeup of Native corporations with and without the creation of the thirteenth region.
