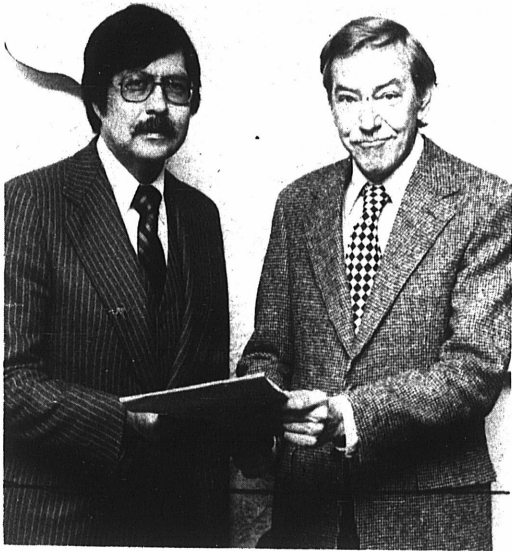

Goldbelt receives title



Joseph Wilson, (l) president of Goldbelt Corporation received land title from BLM's Robert Arnold. An additional 3,442 acres will be conveyed to the Native Village Corporation next spring.

The Bureau of Land Management has conveyed 27,774 acres of land located at Hobart Bay, and Port Houghton south of Juneau to Glodbelt Corporation, the Juneau-based Native corporation. These conveyances come as a result of a land exchange agreement with the Departments of Interior and Agriculture an-

nounced in April of this year in exchange for controversial land selections on Admiralty Island.

"With these conveyances, the Corporation will now embark upon corporate development efforts which will involve land and timber management, as well as looking at investments in the fisheries industry."
