Rivers Says FEC Relaxing Its Policy

Congressman Rslph Rivers has wired Tundra Times that the Federal Electric Corporation has relaxed its policy regarding nonnative employees with native wives in the Arctic.

Rivers wired Friday:

"Regarding your October 18 edition containing item of Federal Electric Corporation policy covering married personnel on the DEWLine, Alvin E. Miller, union shop steward, FEC, contacted me concerning John Brown.

"In turn Bob Chasen, president, FEC, contacted. He advised policy being relaxed to permit overnight visits as long as station covered by required skills.

"After stressing humanitarian aspects of case and even after Brown's last unauthorized absence on the evening of October 21. Chasen assurea Brown would not be terminated."
