

Vice President Postpones His Trip to Alaska

Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey has postponed his trip to Alaska that was scheduled for October 31-November 2.

It was announced that the Vice President was postponing all of his trips distant from Washington, presumably so he could remain close to the nation's capitol.
