

ALASKA STATE POLICE TROOPER APPLICATIONS BEING TAKEN NOW

Commissioner of Public Safety Martin E. Underwood announced applications are now being accepted for Trooper positions with the Alaska State Police.

"Applications are being accepted to fill vacancies now existing, and to provide the Department with a roster of qualified applicants to fill additional vacancies as needed," Commissioner Underwood said.

Applicants must meet the following minimum requirements: resident of Alaska; age 22-35; minimum height, 5'10", with weight proportional; high school graduation or equivalency certificate; applicants must pass a physical examination prior to appointment.

Applicants must also successfully pass competitive written and oral examinations. An extensive background investigation will be conducted to determine applicant's fitness for police work from the standpoint of character, reputation and reliability.
