It was incorrectly reported in the Oct. 15 Tundra Times that the Alaska Native population had declined substantially in the last 30 years. The Page 1 article should have stated that the population has declined in proportion to the non-Native population.

According to the Alaska Department of Labor, in 1960 there were 42,522 Alaska Natives. The total population that year was 226,167, making the percentage of Alaska Native 18,8 percent.

In 1987, there were 78,600 Alaska Natives in a total population of 537,800. The percentage of Alaska Natives in 1987 was 14.6 percent.
