

Board wants recommendations for spring big game meeting

JUNEAU — The Alaska Board of Game is accepting proposed changes in regulations of all big game hunting seasons and bag limits until Jan. 15.

The proposals will be considered during the spring board meeting beginning March 30, according to a board announcement.

Proposals may address hunting seasons and bag limits for all subsistence and general regulations on the harvest of black, brown and grizzly bear, bison, moose, deer, muskoxen, elk, mountain or Dall sheep, mountain goats, caribou and wolverine.

Proposal forms are available at local Department of Fish and Game Offices. Members of the public who wish to submit proposals to local department offices should do so at least three days prior to the deadline. Proposals must be received in a Division of Boards of-

fice by 4:30 p.m. Jan. 15.
