

# Seeking Mother Of the Year

A search for the Alaska Mother of the Year is now underway with the deadline for nominations being March 15.

Civic, fraternal, social and religious organizations, or members of families are invited to nominate candidates.

To qualify, a candidate must have no children younger than 15 years of age, and the character and achievements of her children must indicate that she has been a successful mother.

Furthermore, the candidate must be an active member in her church or synagogue and have a sense of responsibility in civic affairs and be active in service for public benefit.

Sponsored locally by the Business and Professional Women's Club, the Alaska Mother of the Year will be selected by a jury made up of selected leaders of women's and men's organizations engaged in religious or civic work within the State. From the State nominees a National Mother is chosen.
